



Alanya Marina is a gateway to the Eastern Mediterranean ports of Cyprus, Syria, Lebanon, Israel and Egypt. Alanya is only 125 Km. far from the international Antalya airport which provides good flight connections to all over Europe. Alanya has more than 200 sunny days and blue sky with no cloud and the climate is very mild during winter months. Alanya is a medium size city, 115.000 inhabitants but still is unspoiled and keeps the charming style of the tourist resort with a small International population of Turkish, German, British, Dutch and many other nations. Marina is very well protected by the solid breakwater provides excellent protection against winds from all directions. Today Alanya is one of the biggest tourist centres in the Mediterranean with the capacity for over hundred fifty thousand beds for tourists.

HISTORY: It is not yet known by whom or when Alanya was built. In the antique era Alanya was situated between the boundaries of Pamphilia and Kilikia. Herodotus states the people that lived in the region between Pamphilia and Kilikia one descendants of people who spread to Anatolia after the Trojan War. The first historical name of Alanya is Coracesium. The person who mentioned the name of 'Coracesium' for the first time in history was 4th B.C. geographer Skylaks. At that time this region was under the invasion of the Persians. After some time the city become an important center for the Mediterranean pirates and got strong enough to resist the Roman navy and became a base of the frightening pirate of the Mediterranean: Dryphon. Cora cesium continued to be a home for the pirates for some more time. In 65 B.C., the city became a part of Rome after a naval attack by the Roman Commander, Magnus Pompeius. During Byzantium era the city had a new name; Kalonoros which means beautiful mountain, that was given by the sailors. In 1221, The Selçuk Sultan Alaaddin Keykubat, seized the control of the city that he had besieged for some time, He gave the city, the name of Alanya after his own name. Alaiye became a part of Memluk State in Egypt in 1427 and than a part of the Ottoman Empire in 1471 by Fatih, the Conqueror.






Arrival & Departure Formalities

All formalities on your arrival into the Delta Marina will be performed by Marina office; Marina staff helps you for mooring to the berth.

Marina office informs the imigration and health office about your arrival

All crew should wait on the boat until they come.

The imigration takes your passports to keep until your departure and gives landing cards to you to keep during your stay. After finishing the formalitations, the captain bring the boat papers and the crew list to marina office to prepare the arrival declaration to Harbour Master





Delta Marina which is continuing its activities since 1996, is located at the pearl of Cyprus, Kyrenia, also it is only 1 km. away from the city center that is famous with its historical tissue. Marina, is located 35 km. from Ercan airport, 2 km. from bus terminal. The town centre (app. 15 minutes walk) offers visitors many forms of shopping and other conveniences such as banking, exchange bureaus and restaurants. The establishment, which is constructed on a area of 9000 m², is capable of mooring 80 yachts, and also 80 yachts on the land. In the marina, 24 hours security service, mail,telephone and fax service, tourist information, ticket-hotel reservation, renting car and daily weather report services provided. The marina has a quay of 75 meters and 2 floating pontoons of 30 and 40 meters, giving a total mooring length capacity of 285 meters which 75-80 yachts can berth. The capacity of yachts that can be kept on the dry are 80.

The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) covers an area of 3,555 square kilometers.

According to the 2006 estimates 250,000 people live in TRNC.

Total shorline length of TRNC is 396 km.

- The average annual temperature is 20°C & Summer temperatures average 30°C with the coldest months of January and February 10°C
- . 1,900 kinds of flowering plants grow wild in TRNC & 30 kinds of orchids only grow in TRNC

Among the 350 species of birds, 7 are endemic to North Cyprus.

- The beaches of North Cyprus are also a good nestling places for two well known sea turtle specie Caretta Caretta and Chelonia Mydas in the Mediterranean
- . In the Karpaz National Park area (Pan handle) about 250 donkeys are living in wild nature

Visitors can also take adventage of nature walks and other sporting activities throught the region.

 Girne (Kyrenia) is the pearl of TRNC, but do not fail to visit natural and historical sites throught all regions of the TRNC. All regions are easily accessible by bus, or minibus.

All country's flags are welcome in to T.R.N.C. 24 hours a day without any visa. First entry to the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus must be via in Famagusta Port or Kyrenia (Delta Marina)





PORT CYPRIUM MARINA, GIRNE/N. CYPRUS





Port Cyprium Marina and Village with a capacity of 543-berths is to be built 30 kilometres east of Girne as part of a scheme to boost yacht tourism in North Cyprus.

Work on the new marina and its linked Port Cyprium Village development of 32 luxury villas (already underway with the show-house completed) is scheduled to begin by the end of March 2009 in and around a cove at Kuchůk Erenkoy, near Esentepe.

Port Cyprium Marina is designed to maximise the yacht tourism potential of the country's coastal waters, most of which were officially opened to the public last year for the first time since 1974. Only small areas of sea around Snake Island, Teknecik Power Station, Varosha (south Faqmagusta), and between Erenkoy and Limniti on the TRNC's western border are still "off-limits" to non-military vessels.

Port Cyprium Village and Marina complex, which is expected to be completed in two years, is a 25 minute drive from Girne and just 20 minute from Ercan Airport via the Gecitkale pass on the new north coast road. Larnaka airport in south Cyprus is just one hours' taxi journey.

The marina will be equipped with full boat-lifting, repair and servicing facilities. It will also feature a clubhouse with 20 guest rooms, a traditional Cypriot taverna offering Cypriot cuisine and three restaurants offering fine dining to fast food, spa, gym and two tennis courts. A range of watersports, including diving and sailing, will also be available.

Port Cyprium Marina is overlooked by the nearby Moulos archaeological site and benefits from a nearby natural breakwater to provide additional protection for yachts.

In terms of location, it has the benefit of being close to Girne and the airport and to the newly-opened 21-hole Konneum Golf and Country Club, which is just ten minutes along the main coastal road. It also lies on the cross-roads of civilisations linking the ancient city of Salamis, north of Famagusta, St. Barnabas Monastery and other ancient ruins along the Karpas Peninsula such as Kantara Castle, Aghios Philon Church, Aphendrika and Apostolos Andreas right on the eastern tip of Cyprus.

Other historical sites are located within one hours' drive to the west of Kyrenia such as Soli and Vouni known as one of the Nine Kingdoms of Cyprus as well as the famous Ottoman town of Lefka luscious with its citrus groves and the old Roman copper mines.





LATTAKIA MARINA, SYRIA



Lattakia Marina opened in 2000 as the first marina in Syria. It has a berthing capacity for 50 yachts on the water and 50 on land, equipped with all needs of yachtsmen, service station provided with water and electricity, communication services, slipway for boats up to 40 m length, play ground for childeren, yacht maintanence, restaurant and cafeteria. Depth in the Marina varies from 2 to 6 m. Lattakia Marina receives. The Eastern Mediterranean Yacht Rally "EMYR" every year that starts from Turkey towards Lattakia in Syria, Jounieh in Lebanon then to Port Said in Egypt and passes other places. Syria is the cradle of civilization. Archaeologist believe that under each rock in Syria; one can find part of the history. Syria is the land of Cham (the second son of Noah according to the Bible) of whom the Canaanitis were descended. It was situtued among three continents and witnessed most of the important events of history, and the great nations of ancient time: Assyrians - Babyylions - Phoenicians - Arameas - Greek - Romans...... etc.

Influence and affection were the consequences of the innovations, people passed by Syria left their crafts, arts, gods and legends to add more to the human inheritance and knowledge. 

JOUNIEH ATCL CLUB MARINA / LEBANON



Jounieh is a club marina and has the best location and facilities in Lebanon. It is an port of entry and the marina management assist with the formalities. The marina has no technical service department but can make recommendations for outside contractors. The marina is in the city of Jounieh and all the shops, markets, restaurants, seaside cafeterias are within walking distance.

Beirut is only 20 Km away and is easily accessabile by taxi, it has been compleatly rebuilt since the war and now assumes its former place as the Paris of the East. Traditional restaurants share space with modern bistros cafes, designer stores and traditional bazars. Jounieh ATCL Marina is also the safest place to leave the yacht for certain time to discover inland or even neighbour countries. Beirut is only 20 Km and it is always easily accessable to have a dinner in Beirut and return the club marina by taxi. International Beirut airport offers excelent air connections to the rest of the world with schedule and charter flights all year round.

Lebanon is very rich in archelogical sites, and boasts an challanging ski area just outside the city. You will certainly not be board spending a wintering period here. ATCL Jounieh Marina has a Half Olympic size swimming pool, tennis courts, indoor fitness center and very well organised restaurant facilities.

Motor boats will be asked to divert to the following waypoint: N 33 55 00; E 35 13 00, 13 nautical miles west of Beirut. They will be asked to bear 090 in the course of the access channel.

Sailing boats will be allowed to proceed directly to ATCL Marina.

Keep listening on the VHF for further instructions.

It is recommended to contact the marina Harbor Master prior your trip to Lebanon, so he can arrange your passage.







Visitors can safely leave their boats in the Marina for short visits to Cairo or for wintering in Egypt. The Red sea offers two modern Marinas further south and many safe anchorages, but strong winds can occur.

Abu Tig Marina is a unique and exciting project on the Red Sea coast of Egypt. The marina town was designed by the Italian architect Alfredo Freda and the basin by Sogreah Ingenerie, France. The marina town with an area of over 140,000 square meters is just part of the world class touristic resort - El Gouna. The marina town contains two 4 star hotels, three smaller hotels, restaurants, cafes, bars, shops and the marina basin (yacht harbour) and is the first of its kind in the Red Sea. Phase I of the marina town was opened in January 2001 and includes five apartment blocks, shops, restaurants, bars, cafes and the marina basin itself. The remaining Hotels were completed as part of Phase II and were finished by autumn 2003. Real estate apartments offer glorious panoramic views overlooking the marina basin with its many yachts and out to the open sea. Apartments vary in size from 50 - 188 square meters, one, two and three bedroom units with private entrance. All units have either large private roof top areas or private gardens.
